

Volunteering – Special Circumstances

Community Service Volunteers

We currently do not have volunteer opportunities for individuals completing Community Service hours through the court.

Youth/8th Grade Service Project Volunteers (Individual)

Youth are able to complete our general orientation and become regular volunteers. The following information addresses youth who have specific service project requirements.

We are able to accept approximately 4-5 students in the spring and fall for youth service projects. Students must make arrangements with the Pantry Coordinator. Specific dates and times will be scheduled in advance. We allow only one student per pantry shift. We require a minimum of 2 weeks' notice to be able to schedule activities for specific students. All students are required to read, sign, and agree to our confidentiality standards.

We may not be able to accommodate all youth who need service project hours. Plan ahead and contact us early to be sure to have an opportunity for service hours.

University/College Student Volunteers (Individual)

We can accommodate 1-2 college age students who have service learning requirements per semester. Students need to contact the Pantry Coordinator with a minimum of 4 weeks' notice prior to beginning service learning. Be upfront and specific about the hours and activities required to meet your class specifications.

We may not be able to accommodate all college age students who need service learning hours. Plan ahead. Students who wait until half way through or later in the semester may not be able to be accommodated in a timely manner.

Group Volunteers

Volunteer groups such as church, university/college, or employer groups seeking out volunteer opportunities at the Pantry may be accommodated on a limited basis. We require a minimum of 1 month notice to schedule group volunteer opportunities. We will work with groups to the best of our ability, but volunteer opportunities may not be available at all times and all days. Contact the Pantry Coordinator to discuss a possible day and time to volunteer.
