



Frequently Asked Questions

Who can receive food and clothing?

Food and clothing are available for Johnson County individuals and families.

How often can I receive food or clothing?

Food can be picked up once weekly. Four items of clothing per family member can be picked up monthly.

Do I need to be a member of the church or attend services to receive items?

No, all community members are welcome to use the pantry.

Does it matter where I live?

In-area individuals and families are people who live in:

- North Liberty
- Small towns (Oxford, Tiffin, Solon, etc) in Johnson County
- Rural areas of Johnson County

In-area families can select their own food and clothing.

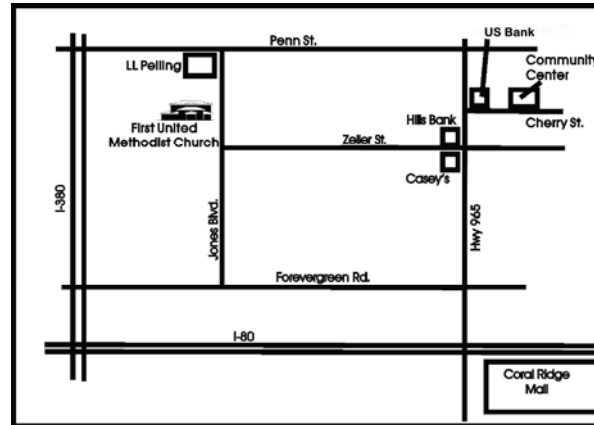
Out-of-area individuals and families are people who live in

- Coralville
- Iowa City
- Outside Johnson County

Out-of-area families can receive sacked food once and a small amount of government commodities after that.

Are my records confidential?

Yes, all records are confidential and are not used for any other purpose.

Our mission is to engage the community in feeding and clothing our neighbors



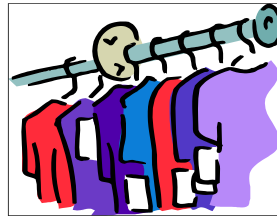
Food Pantry

The Food Pantry was started in 1985. We offer fresh bread, produce, and frozen foods, in addition to canned and packed groceries.

Food can be picked up once a week. If you live in our service area*, you can select your own food. If you live outside our service area, you will receive sacked food.

* Our service area includes:

- North Liberty
- Small towns (Oxford, Tiffin, Solon, etc) in Johnson County
- Rural areas of Johnson County



Clothing Pantry

The Clothing Pantry is available to individuals and families in our service area*. It stocks children's clothing for all ages. Adult clothing is limited to outer wear and maternity.

Four items of clothing per family member can be picked up each month.



Deliveries

In special situations deliveries can be made to North Liberty residences. Deliveries are only made on Tuesdays. Please contact us at 626-2711 at least 24 hours in advance to make arrangements.



Paperwork

In order to use the food and clothing pantry we need you to:

- Fill out a HACAP form once yearly.
- Complete a family information sheet once yearly.
- Bring an ID and a recent piece of mail (such as a utility bill) that shows your current address.

All records are confidential and not used for any other purpose.
